




# Tips for creating MG



#### 1. Tell a story

Simplicity and clarity are key

Who am I trying to reach?
What do I want them to learn? Remember? Do?
How do I want to make them feel?

## Tips for creating MG

#### 2. Know your run time

MG tend to be 30sec or a minute and half. Think about the medium where it will be shown

#### 3. Let visuals do the heavy lifting

Find opportunities to show, not tell.

eg. Com Service Dept report figures is shown on screen, audio provide context

#### 4. Animation style


Watch your transitions. Do not use every transition and effects Keep a good pace, too fast and audience won't be able to read, too slow and audience might gets bored

#### 5. Sound

Choose appropriate music and sound effects.


Ensure that music is not competing with VO volume.

VO must be related to what is shown on screen.




